- I. The **Concept** of God's Name, "Your name"
 - A. In the Bible the names of God are synonymous with His <u>character</u> and attributes.

Matthew 6:9-13

- I. The **Concept** of God's Name, "Your name"
 - A. In the Bible the names of God are synonymous with His character and attributes.
 - B. God has been revealed most fully to us through <u>Jesus Christ</u>, Hebrews 1:3; Colossians 2:9; 1 John 5:12



Matthew 6:9-13

- II. The <u>Consecration</u> of <u>God's Name</u>, "Hallowed..."
 - A. "Hallowed" = holy, set apart, consecrated



Matthew 6:9-13

"That God's name should be hallowed is to say that God should have His own honour of which He is so worthy, so that men should never think or speak of Him without the greatest veneration." - John Calvin, "Calvin's Commentary"



Matthew 6:9-13

- II. The <u>Consecration</u> of God's Name, "Hallowed...,"
 - B. "Hallowed" used in two ways:
 - 1. To be made holy, 1 Peter 1:16
 - 2. To treat someone or something as sacred

- II. The <u>Consecration</u> of God's Name, "Hallowed...,"
 - C. To "Hallow" God's name is to:
 - 1. Honour God as holy, Isaiah 6:3
 - 2. Stand in <u>awe</u>, Isaiah 29:23; Psalm 33:8

- G. Adore Him in out hearts, Matthew 1533 Palm 1533
- D. Respectfully speak about Him, Ex. 20:7; Lev. 19:12

- Do Respectfully speak about Him, Ex. 2037; Lev. 19312
- E. Keep the Sabbath holy, Exodus 20:8-11

Jesus teaches us about the Person who is the priority of prayer

- E. Keep the Sabbath holy, Exodus 20:3-11
- F. Bring credit to Him by the way we <u>live</u>, Matthew 5:16; Colossians 3:1



Matthew 6:9-13

Question: How is God's name hallowed among us?

Answer: God's name is kept holy when His Word is taught in it's truth and purity, and we as children of God lead holy lives according to it... but whoever teaches and lives contrary to God's Word dishonours God's name among us..."

Matthew 6:9-13

Jesus teaches us about the Person who is the priority of prayer

How can we live holy lives?

- 1. By living in obedience to the Word of God, Psa.119:11
- 2. By cultivating a heart for God, Colossians 3:1
- 3. By not grieving (Ephesians 4:30) nor quenching (1 Thess. 5:19) the Holy Spirit
