THE LAST WEEK BEFORE CALVARY

Mark 11

Now when they drew near to Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany, at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of his disciples ² and said to them, "Go into the village in front of you, and immediately as you enter it you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it. ³ If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord has need of it and will send it back here immediately.'" ⁴ And they went away and found a colt tied at a door outside in the street, and they untied it.

⁵ And some of those standing there said to them, "What are you doing, untying the colt?" ⁶ And they told them what Jesus had said, and they let them go. ⁷ And they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks on it, and he sat on it. ⁸ And many spread their cloaks on the road, and others spread leafy branches that they had cut from the fields. ⁹ And those who went before and those who followed were shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! ¹⁰ Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David! Hosanna in the highest!"

²¹ And Peter remembered and said to him, "Rabbi, look! The fig tree that you cursed has withered."

²² And Jesus answered them, "Have faith in God.

²³ Truly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and thrown into the sea,' and does not doubt..."

Controversy about Jesus' Authority

²⁸ ...and they said to him, "By what authority are you doing these things, or who gave you this authority to do them?"

²⁹ Jesus said to them, "I will ask you one question; answer me, and I will tell you by what authority I do these things. ³⁰ Was the baptism of John from heaven or from man? Answer me."

Controversy about paying Taxes

Ch 12

"Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?"

"Bring me a denarius and let me look at it..."

Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's,
and to God the things that are God's."

And they marveled at him.

TUESDAY: THE DAY OF CONFLICT

Controversy about the Resurrection

²⁰ There were seven brothers... ²³ In the resurrection, when they rise again, whose wife will she be? For the seven had her as wife..."

²⁴ Jesus said to them, "Is this not the reason you are wrong, because you know neither the Scriptures nor the power of God? ²⁵ For when they rise from the dead, they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven."

TUESDAY: THE DAY OF CONFLICT

Controversy about the Law

²⁹ "The most important is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. ³⁰ And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' ³¹ The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

Conflict about Giving

⁴³ "Truly, I say to you, this poor widow has put in more than all those who are contributing to the offering box. ⁴⁴ For they all contributed out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty has put in everything she had, all she had to live on."

Ch 13

⁵ "See that no one leads you astray. ⁶ Many will come in my name, saying, 'I am he!' and they will lead many astray. ⁷ And when you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be alarmed... These are but the beginning of the birth pains.

⁹ But be on your guard..."
